10	watering restriction" means a temporary restriction of water use to
11	irrigate residential vegetation or turf that is mandated by a
12	municipality, water utility, or other wholesale or retail water
13	supplier as part of a strategy to conserve water during a period of
14	drought.
15	(b) A property owners' association may not assess a fine
16	against a property owner for a violation of an applicable
17	restrictive covenant that requires the owner to maintain green
18	vegetation or turf or prohibits discolored or brown vegetation or
19	turf on the property:
20	(1) during a period when the owner's property is
21	subject to a residential watering restriction under which
22	discolored or brown vegetation or turf could reasonably result; and
