5	SECTION 1. Section 264.7541(c), Family Code, is amended to

7	(c) Once a child is placed with a relative or other
8	designated caregiver, the department shall inform the caregiver \underline{in}
9	writing of:
10	(1) the option to become verified by a licensed
11	child-placing agency to operate an agency foster home, if
12	applicable, and the process for becoming an agency foster home;
13	(2) the difference between an unverified relative or
14	other designated caregiver and an agency foster home, including the
15	amount of additional financial assistance the relative or other
16	designated caregiver would receive after becoming an agency foster
17	home;
18	(3) the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
19	program including:
20	(A) the qualifications for the program;
21	(B) the process for applying for benefits under
22	the program; and
23	(C) the amount of financial benefits under the
24	program;

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1	(4) the availability of any financial assistance
2	available under this subchapter;
3	<u>(5)</u> [and
4	[(2)] the permanency care assistance program under
5	Subchapter K <u>; and</u>
6	(6) any other financial benefit available to a
7	relative or other designated caregiver.
8	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
