SECTION 2. Section 2306.6741, Government Code, as added by 1-31 1-32 this Act, applies only to a development that receives an allocation 1-33 of low income housing tax credits from an application cycle that is 1-34 based on the 2026 qualified allocation plan or a subsequent plan adopted by the governing board of the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs. A development that receives an allocation of low income housing tax credits from an application cycle that is 1-35 1-36 1-37 based on an earlier qualified allocation plan is governed by the law 1-38 1-39 in effect on the date the application cycle began, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 1-40
