## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to reporting information regarding certain evidence

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 420.034, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (h) and adding Subsection (i) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (h) Not later than December 1 of each year, the department
- 9 shall submit a report to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker
- 10 of the house of representatives, and members of the legislature
- 11 identifying the number of evidence collection kits:
- 12 <u>(1)</u> that have not yet been submitted for laboratory
- 13 analysis or for which the laboratory analysis has not yet been
- 14 completed, as applicable; and
- 15 (2) that a law enforcement agency did not take
- 16 possession of within the period required by Section 420.035(b) or
- 17 (c), as applicable.
- 18 <u>(i)</u> The annual report <u>required by Subsection (h)</u> must be
- 19 titled "Statewide Electronic Tracking System Report" and must be
- 20 posted on the department's publicly accessible Internet website.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 351.257, Local Government Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 351.257. REPORT. Not later than December 1 of each
- 24 odd-numbered year, a response team shall provide to the

- 1 commissioners court of each county the response team serves a
- 2 report that includes:
- 3 (1) a list of response team members able to
- 4 participate in the quarterly meetings required by Section
- 5 351.254(c);
- 6 (2) a copy of the written protocol developed under
- 7 Section 351.256; and
- 8 (3) either:
- 9 (A) a biennial summary detailing:
- 10 (i) the number of sexual assault reports
- 11 received by local law enforcement agencies;
- 12 (ii) the number of investigations conducted
- 13 as a result of those reports;
- 14 (iii) the number of indictments presented
- 15 in connection with a report and the disposition of those cases;
- 16 [<del>and</del>]
- 17 (iv) the number of reports of sexual
- 18 assault for which no indictment was presented; and
- 19 <u>(v)</u> the number of evidence collection kits
- 20 described by Section 420.031, Government Code, that a law
- 21 enforcement agency did not take possession of within the period
- 22 required by Section 420.035(b) or (c), Government Code, as
- 23 <u>applicable;</u> or
- 24 (B) an explanation of the reason the response
- 25 team failed to provide the information described by Paragraph (A).
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
