- 6 SECTION 1. Section 434.032(a), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) In a county with a population of 200,000 or more, the
- 9 commissioners court shall maintain a veterans county service
- 10 office. The office must:
- 11 (1) be separate and distinct from other county
- 12 offices;
- 13 (2) be staffed by at least one full-time employee; and
- 14 (3) report directly to the commissioners court or a
- 15 <u>designated county executive official</u>.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
