(a) The division shall require each department to:

2 (1) keep financial and statistical records determined3 necessary by the division;

4 (2) submit <u>the department's budget and</u> [a] strategic
5 plan and all supporting information requested by the division;

6 (3) present data requested by the division as 7 necessary to determine the amount of state aid for which the 8 department is eligible;

9 (4) submit periodic financial audits and statistical 10 reports to the division; and

(5) submit to the Department of Public Safety the full name, address, date of birth, social security number, and driver's license number of each person restricted to the operation of a motor vehicle equipped with a device that uses a deep-lung breath analysis mechanism to make impractical the operation of the motor vehicle if ethyl alcohol is detected in the breath of the restricted operator.

SECTION 4. The heading to Section 509.007, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 5. Section 509.007, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to read as follows:

(a) The division shall require as a condition to payment of
state aid to a department or county under Section 509.011 that:
(1) the department submit the department's budget for

27 the state fiscal biennium and a strategic plan to the division; and

(2) the department's budget and plan be approved by the 1 division [be submitted for the department. The department shall 2 submit the plan required by this subsection. A department may not 3 submit a plan under this section unless the plan is first approved 4 by the judges described by Section 76.002 who established the 5 department]. 6 7 (a-1) A [The] department shall submit a revised strategic plan to the division each even-numbered year not later than March 1. 8 9 (a-2) A department's budget or strategic plan may be amended at any time with the approval of the division. 10 SECTION 6. Section 140.004, Local Government Code, 11 is amended to read as follows: 12 Sec. 140.004. BUDGETS OF CERTAIN JUVENILE BOARDS 13 [AND COMMUNITY SUPERVISION AND CORRECTIONS DEPARTMENTS]. 14 (a) This 15 section applies only to [+ 16 [(1)] a juvenile board, juvenile probation office, or juvenile department established for one or more counties[; and 17 18 [(2) a community supervision and corrections department established for a judicial district]. 19 20 (b) Before the 45th day before the first day of the fiscal year of a county, a juvenile board [and a community supervision and 21 22 corrections department] that <u>has</u> [each have] jurisdiction in the county shall: 23 24 prepare a budget for the board's [or department's] (1)25 next fiscal year; and (2) hold a meeting to finalize the budget. 26 (c) Before the 14th day before the juvenile board [or 27

1 community supervision and corrections department] has a meeting to
2 finalize its budget, the board [or department] shall file with the
3 commissioners court:

4

(1) a copy of the proposed budget; and

5 (2) a statement containing the date of the board's [or
6 department's] meeting to finalize its budget.

7 (d) Before the later of the 90th day after the last day of 8 the juvenile board's [or community supervision and corrections 9 department's] fiscal year, or the date the county auditor's annual 10 report is made to the commissioners court, the board [or 11 department] shall file with the commissioners court a complete 12 financial statement of the board [or department] covering the 13 board's [or department's] preceding fiscal year.

14 (e) The financial statement required by Subsection (d) must 15 contain any information considered appropriate by the juvenile 16 board [or community supervision and corrections department] and any 17 information required by the commissioners court of each county in 18 which the board [or department] has jurisdiction.

The budget for a juvenile board [or community 19 (f) supervision and corrections department] may not include 20 an automobile allowance for a member of the governing body of the board 21 22 [or department] if the member holds another state, county, or municipal office. The budget may include reimbursement of actual 23 24 travel expenses, including mileage for automobile travel, incurred 25 while the member is engaged in the official business of the board [or department]. 26
