5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 311, Health and Safety
7	Code, is amended by adding Section 311.025 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 311.025. SUMMARY OF CERTAIN PARTS OF EMERGENCY
9	OPERATIONS PLAN. (a) In this section:
10	(1) "Commission" means the Health and Human Services
11	Commission.
12	(2) "Emergency operations plan" means a hospital's
13	process for temporarily routing patients in need of emergency
14	services to other hospitals or health facilities during a period
15	when:
16	(A) the hospital's capacity to provide emergency
17	services to those patients is significantly diminished; and
18	(B) the patients, if routed to the hospital,
19	would likely receive substantially delayed care resulting in worse
20	health outcomes than would otherwise occur were the patient routed
21	to another hospital or health facility.
22	(3) "Hospital" means a hospital licensed under Chapter
23	<u>241.</u>
24	(b) This section applies only to a hospital that has an

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1 <u>emergency department or otherwise regularly provides emergency</u> 2 <u>services.</u>
3 <u>(c) A hospital to which this section applies shall submit to</u>
4 <u>the commission a written summary of the part of the hospital's</u>
5 <u>emergency operations plan that addresses diversions from the</u>
6 <u>hospital's emergency department in the event that the hospital</u>

7 experiences a cyber attack or an electrical power outage.

8 <u>(d) If a hospital to which this section applies makes</u> 9 <u>changes to the part of the plan described by Subsection (c), the</u> 10 <u>hospital shall update the previously submitted summary and submit</u> 11 <u>the updated summary to the commission not later than the 30th day</u> 12 <u>after the date the changes to the plan are adopted by the hospital's</u> 13 <u>governing body or otherwise approved by the appropriate hospital</u> 14 <u>administrator.</u>

15 (e) A summary submitted to the commission under this section 16 is confidential and excepted from public disclosure under Chapter 17 <u>552, Government Code.</u>

18 SECTION 2. A hospital to which Section 311.025, Health and 19 Safety Code, as added by this Act, applies shall comply with the 20 requirements of that section not later than December 1, 2025.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
