5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 311, Health and Safety
7	Code, is amended by adding Section 311.025 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 311.025. SUMMARY OF CERTAIN PARTS OF EMERGENCY
9	DEPARTMENT DIVERSION PLAN. (a) In this section:
10	(1) "Commission" means the Health and Human Services
11	Commission.
12	(2) "Diversion plan" means a hospital's process for
13	temporarily routing patients in need of emergency services to other
14	hospitals or health facilities during a period when:
15	(A) the hospital's capacity to provide emergency
16	services to those patients is significantly diminished; and
17	(B) the patients, if routed to the hospital,
18	would likely receive substantially delayed care resulting in worse
19	health outcomes than would otherwise occur were the patient routed
20	to another hospital or health facility.
21	(3) "Hospital" means a hospital licensed under Chapter
22	<u>241.</u>
23	(b) This section applies only to a hospital that has an
24	emergency department or otherwise regularly provides emergency

- 2 (c) A hospital to which this section applies shall submit to
- 3 the commission a written summary of the part of the hospital's
- 4 diversion plan that addresses diversions from the hospital's
- 5 emergency department in the event that the hospital experiences a
- 6 cyber attack or an electrical power outage.
- 7 (d) If a hospital to which this section applies makes
- 8 changes to the part of the plan described by Subsection (c), the
- 9 hospital shall update the previously submitted summary and submit
- 10 the updated summary to the commission not later than the 30th day
- 11 after the date the changes to the plan are adopted by the hospital's
- 12 governing body or otherwise approved by the appropriate hospital
- 13 administrator.
- 14 (e) A summary submitted to the commission under this section
- 15 is confidential and excepted from public disclosure under Chapter
- 16 552, Government Code.
- 17 SECTION 2. A hospital to which Section 311.025, Health and
- 18 Safety Code, as added by this Act, applies shall comply with the
- 19 requirements of that section not later than December 1, 2025.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
