| 4  | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:            |
| 5  | SECTION 1. Chapter 411, Government Code, is amended by             |
| 6  | adding Subchapter H-1 to read as follows:                          |
| 7  | SUBCHAPTER H-1. REGISTRATION OF FIREARMS                           |
| 8  | Sec. 411.221. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "firearm"            |
| 9  | has the meaning assigned by Section 46.01, Penal Code.             |
| 10 | Sec. 411.222. RULEMAKING AUTHORITY; ADMINISTRATION. (a)            |
| 11 | The commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement this       |
| 12 | subchapter.  |
| 13 | (b) The department shall:  |
| 14 | (1) administer this subchapter and the rules adopted               |
| 15 | by the director under this subchapter; and                         |
| 16 | (2) take action necessary to ensure compliance with                |
| 17 | this subchapter.   |
| 18 | Sec. 411.223. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS. (a) This                  |
| 19 | subchapter applies to a person who:                                |
| 20 | (1) is a resident of this state and who on or after                |
| 21 | January 1, 2026, acquires a firearm for the purpose of possessing  |
| 22 | the firearm in this state; or                                      |
| 23 | (2) enters this state on or after January 1, 2026, for             |
| 24 | the purpose of residing in this state and who possesses a firearm, |

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| regardless of when the person acquired the firearm.                 |
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| (b) A person to whom this subchapter applies shall submit an        |
| application for a certificate of registration for a firearm with    |
| the department on a form prescribed by the department that includes |
| the information described by Subsection (c) not later than the 30th |
| day after the date the person:                                      |
| (1) acquires the firearm, if the person is described                |
| by Subsection (a)(1); or  |
| (2) enters this state with the firearm, if the person               |
| is described by Subsection (a)(2).                                  |
| (c) The application must include:                                   |
| (1) the owner's:  |
| (A) full name and place and date of birth;                          |
| (B) residence and business addresses; and                           |
| (C) driver's license number or identification                       |
| certificate number issued by the department, or if the owner is a   |
| new resident of this state, information necessary to prove identity |
| to the satisfaction of the department;                              |
| (2) the name of the manufacturer of the firearm;                    |
| (3) the model, type of action, caliber or gauge, and                |
| serial number of the firearm; and                                   |
| (4) the source from which the firearm was obtained,                 |
| including the previous owner's name and address.                    |
| (d) An application for a certificate of registration must be        |
| accompanied by the required registration fee.                       |
| Sec. 411.224. REGISTRATION FEE. The department shall                |
| charge for issuance of a certificate of registration a reasonable   |
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| 1  | fee in the amount necessary to cover the costs of administering this |
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| 2  | subchapter.  |
| 3  | Sec. 411.225. CHANGE OF INFORMATION. If the information              |
| 4  | provided to the department in connection with a certificate of       |
| 5  | registration changes, the certificate holder shall notify the        |
| 6  | department in the form and manner prescribed by the department not   |
| 7  | later than the 30th day after the date the change occurs.            |
| 8  | Sec. 411.226. CRIMINAL OFFENSE. (a) A person commits an              |
| 9  | offense if the person fails to register a firearm in violation of    |
| 10 | this subchapter.   |
| 11 | (b) An offense under Subsection (a) is a Class C                     |
| 12 | misdemeanor.   |
| 13 | SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2025:                          |
| 14 | (1) the public safety director of the Department of                  |
| 15 | Public Safety of the State of Texas shall adopt the rules necessary  |
| 16 | to implement Subchapter H-1, Chapter 411, Government Code, as added  |
| 17 | by this Act; and   |
| 18 | (2) the department shall create the application form                 |
| 19 | and the change of information form required by Subchapter H-1,       |
| 20 | Chapter 411, Government Code, as added by this Act.                  |
| 21 | SECTION 3. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this          |
| 22 | section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2025.                    |
| 23 | (b) Section 411.226, Government Code, as added by this Act,          |
| 24 | takes effect January 1, 2026.  |
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
