## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to electricity pricing rules and operating procedures that eliminate or compensate for market distortion caused by certain 3 federal tax credits. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 39.171 to read as follows: Sec. 39.171. MARKET DISTORTION RESPONSE. 8 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, the commission 9 and the ERCOT independent system operator shall adopt rules, 10 operating procedures, and protocols to eliminate or compensate for 11 any distortion in electricity pricing in the ERCOT power region 12 caused by a federal tax credit provided under 26 U.S.C. Section 45. 13 14 (b) Rules, operating procedures, and protocols adopted under this section must ensure that costs imposed on the system by 15 16 the sale of electricity that is eligible for a federal tax credit provided under 26 U.S.C. Section 45, including costs of maintaining 17 sufficient capacity to serve load at the summer peak demand caused 18 by the loss of new investment from below-market prices, are paid by 19 the parties that impose the costs. 20 21 (c) In conjunction with adopting rules, operating procedures, and protocols under this section, the commission and 22 23 the ERCOT independent system operator shall eliminate any rules,

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operating procedures, or protocols that attempt to adjust

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- 2 reserve levels based on the probability of reserves falling below
- 3 the minimum contingency level and the value of lost load.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
