A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the duties of the Texas Maternal Mortality and
- 3 Morbidity Review Committee and the collection, maintenance, and
- 4 disclosure of maternal health records regarding miscarriage and
- 5 lack of access to therapeutic termination of pregnancy.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 34.005, Health and Safety Code, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 34.005. DUTIES OF REVIEW COMMITTEE. The review
- 10 committee shall:
- 11 (1) study and review:
- 12 (A) cases of pregnancy-related deaths, including
- 13 deaths related to miscarriage or threatened miscarriage or
- 14 attributable to lack of access to therapeutic termination of
- 15 pregnancy;
- 16 (B) trends, rates, or disparities in
- 17 pregnancy-related deaths and severe maternal morbidity, including
- 18 severe maternal morbidity related to miscarriage or threatened
- 19 miscarriage or attributable to lack of access to therapeutic
- 20 termination of pregnancy;
- (C) health conditions and factors that
- 22 disproportionately affect the most at-risk population as
- 23 determined in the joint biennial report required under Section
- 24 34.015; and

- 1 (D) best practices and programs operating in
- 2 other states that have reduced rates of pregnancy-related deaths;
- 3 (2) compare rates of pregnancy-related deaths based on
- 4 the socioeconomic status of the mother;
- 5 (3) determine the feasibility of the review committee
- 6 studying cases of severe maternal morbidity; and
- 7 (4) in consultation with the Perinatal Advisory
- 8 Council, make recommendations to help reduce the incidence of
- 9 pregnancy-related deaths and severe maternal morbidity in this
- 10 state.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 34.007, Health and Safety Code, is
- 12 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 13 (d) In addition to the data required under Subsection (b)
- 14 and cases selected under Subsection (c), the department shall
- 15 aggregate and submit to the review committee data regarding cases
- 16 of death and severe maternal morbidity:
- 17 (1) related to miscarriage or threatened miscarriage;
- 18 or
- 19 (2) attributable to lack of access to therapeutic
- 20 termination of pregnancy.
- 21 SECTION 3. Section 34.013, Health and Safety Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 34.013. INAPPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. (a) Except as
- 24 provided by Subsection (b), this [This] chapter does not apply to
- 25 disclosure of records pertaining to voluntary or therapeutic
- 26 termination of pregnancy, and those records may not be collected,
- 27 maintained, or disclosed under this chapter.

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- 1 (b) Records on cases of deaths or severe maternal morbidity
- 2 related to miscarriage or threatened miscarriage or attributable to
- 3 lack of access to therapeutic termination of pregnancy may be
- 4 collected, maintained, and disclosed for purposes of this chapter
- 5 and subject to the requirements of this chapter.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
