If the commission amends the permit 13 after a protectiveness review, the commission shall allow 14 facilities authorized to emit air contaminants under the permit as 15 16 it read before the amendment to continue to operate until a date provided by the commission under Subsection (f) that provides 17 facility operators a reasonable amount of time to comply with the 18
- (k) An application for <u>an authorization to use</u> [the issuance of] a standard permit under this section for a concrete plant that performs wet batching, dry batching, or central mixing, including a permanent, temporary, or specialty concrete batch plant, as defined by the commission, must include a plot plan that clearly shows:

- 1 (1) a distance scale;
- 2 (2) a north arrow;
- 3 (3) all property lines, emission points, buildings,
- 4 tanks, and process vessels and other process equipment in the area
- 5 in which the facility will be located;
- 6 (4) at least two benchmark locations in the area in
- 7 which the facility will be located; and
- 8 (5) if the permit requires a distance, setback, or
- 9 buffer from other property or structures as a condition of the
- 10 permit, whether the required distance or setback will be met.
