4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 552.164 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 552.164. EXCEPTION: CONFIDENTIALITY OF INFORMATION
8	REGARDING FRAUD DETECTION AND DETERRENCE MEASURES. (a)
9	Information in the custody of a governmental body that relates to
10	fraud detection and deterrence measures is confidential and
11	excepted from the requirements of Section 552.021. For purposes of
12	this section, fraud detection information includes risk
13	assessments, reports, data, protocols, technology specifications,
14	manuals, instructions, investigative materials, crossmatches,
15	mental impressions, and communications that may reveal the methods
16	or means by which a governmental body prevents, investigates, or
17	evaluates fraud.
18	(b) The confidentiality protection provided by Subsection
19	(a) does not affect the ability of a governmental body to share
20	information described by Subsection (a) as authorized by other law
21	for law enforcement and fraud detection and prevention purposes.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
