7	Sec. 88.1255. STATEWIDE DATABASE OF FIREFIGHTING
8	EQUIPMENT. (a) In this section, "fire department" means:
9	(1) a volunteer fire department; or
10	(2) a department of a municipality, county, or special
11	district or authority that provides firefighting services.
12	(b) The Texas Forest Service shall create and maintain a
13	comprehensive database that shows in real time the statewide
14	inventory of firefighting equipment that is available for use in
15	responding to wildfires.
16	(c) The database must:
17	(1) include a description of the type of firefighting
18	equipment each fire department in the state has available for use in
19	responding to wildfires;
20	(2) include contact information for the fire
21	department that has the equipment;
22	(3) be searchable by location and equipment type; and
23	(4) be accessible by all fire departments in the state
24	and allow each fire department to update the information in the

1 database regarding the equipment the fire department has available. 2 (d) The Texas Forest Service shall assist a fire department 3 that provides equipment information to the database in updating the database annually or as soon as practicable after any change in the 4 5 availability of the department's firefighting equipment. The Texas Forest Service shall use an electronic notification system to 6 7 remind fire departments, at least once each calendar year, to update the availability of the department's firefighting 8 9 equipment.
