4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 418.004, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subdivision (15) to read as follows:
7	(15) "Forest service" means the Texas A&M Forest
8	Service.
9	SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 418, Government Code, is
10	amended by adding Section 418.059 to read as follows:
11	Sec. 418.059. STATEWIDE DATABASE OF FIREFIGHTING
12	EQUIPMENT. (a) The forest service shall create and maintain a
13	comprehensive database that shows in real time the statewide
14	inventory of firefighting equipment that is available for use in
15	responding to wildfires.
16	(b) The database must:
17	(1) include a description of the type of firefighting
18	equipment each fire department in the state has available for use in
19	responding to wildfires;
20	(2) include contact information for the fire
21	department that has the equipment;
22	(3) be searchable by location and equipment type; and
23	(4) be accessible by all fire departments in the state
24	and allow each fire department to update the information in the

1 <u>database regarding the equipment the fire department has available.</u>
2 <u>(c) The forest service may assist fire departments who</u>
3 <u>choose to provide equipment information in updating the database</u>
4 <u>annually or as soon as practicable after any change in the</u>
5 <u>availability of the department's firefighting equipment.</u>
6 <u>(d) In this section, "fire department" includes a volunteer</u>
7 <u>fire department or an emergency services district.</u>

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8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
