BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 61.06642 to read as follows: Sec. 61.06642. REPORT REGARDING ENROLLMENT AND SUCCESS IN 8 HIGHER EDUCATION FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES. (a) In this 9 section, "student with a disability" means a student covered under: 10 (1) the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 11 12 U.S.C. Section 12101 et seq.); or 13 (2) Section 504, Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. Section 794). 14 15 (b) Not later than December 1, 2027, the board shall prepare and submit to the legislature a report on enrollment and success in 16 17 higher education for students with a disability. (c) The report must identify, to the extent practicable: 18 19 (1) the number and percentage of students with a disability who enroll in an institution of higher education or 20 private or independent institution of higher education; 21 22 (2) barriers to enrollment in higher education for 23 students with a disability;

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(3) policies of institutions of higher education or

- 1 private or independent institutions of higher education that
- 2 promote enrollment and success in higher education for students
- 3 with a disability;
- 4 (4) what services and accommodations for students with
- 5 a disability are provided for accessibility at institutions of
- 6 higher education or private or independent institutions of higher
- 7 education;
- 8 (5) what institutions of higher education or private
- 9 or independent institutions of higher education do to provide to
- 10 students with a disability sufficient and accurate information
- 11 regarding the educational rights and protections for persons with a
- 12 disability under state and federal law; and
- 13 (6) any recommendations for legislative or other
- 14 action.
- 15 (d) An institution of higher education shall provide to the
- 16 board on request, and the board may request from a private or
- 17 <u>independent institution of higher education</u>, any information
- 18 necessary for the board to prepare the report.
- 19 (e) This section expires September 1, 2028.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
