- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 12A.004(a), Education Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A local innovation plan may not provide for the
- 8 exemption of a district designated as a district of innovation from
- 9 the following provisions of this title:
- 10 (1) a state or federal requirement applicable to an
- 11 open-enrollment charter school operating under Subchapter D,
- 12 Chapter 12;

- 13 (2) Subchapters A, C, D, and E, Chapter 11, except that
- 14 a district may be exempt from Sections 11.1511(b)(5) and (14) and
- 15 Section 11.162;
- 16 (3) transfers of students who are the children of
- 17 peace officers under Section 25.0344;
- 18 (4) (4) state curriculum and graduation
- 19 requirements adopted under Chapter 28; and
- 20 (5) (4) academic and financial accountability and
- 21 sanctions under Chapters 39 and 39A.
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 25.0344, Education Code, as added by
- 23 Chapter 322 (H.B. 1959), Acts of the 88th Legislature, Regular
- 24 Session, 2023, is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding

- 1 Subsections (e) and (f) to read as follows:
- 2 (b) On request of a peace officer who is a parent of or
- 3 person standing in parental relation to a student, the board of
- 4 trustees of a school district or the board's designee shall
- 5 transfer the student to:
- 6 (1) another district campus; or
- 7 (2) any other [to another] school district in this
- 8 state, regardless of whether the sending district and the receiving
- 9 <u>district have entered into</u> [under] an agreement under Section
- 10 25.035.
- 11 (e) Notwithstanding any other law, both the sending
- 12 district and the receiving district must approve a transfer under
- 13 this section without exception.
- 14 (f) A school district may not charge a tuition fee under
- 15 Section 25.038 to a student who transfers to the district under this
- 16 <u>section</u>.
- SECTION 3. Section 12A.004(a), Education Code, as amended
- 18 by this Act, applies only to a local innovation plan adopted or
- 19 renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A local
- 20 innovation plan adopted or renewed before the effective date of
- 21 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the plan was
- 22 adopted or renewed, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 23 that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 25 school year.
- 26 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
