5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 51.282(c), Education Code, is amended to
7	read as follows:
8	(c) Each postsecondary educational institution shall
9	require each entering freshman or undergraduate transfer student to
10	attend an orientation on the institution's sexual harassment,
11	sexual assault, dating violence, and stalking policy before or
12	during the first semester or term in which the student is enrolled
13	at the institution. The institution shall establish the format and
14	content of the orientation. The orientation:
15	(1) may be provided online; and
16	(2) must include <u>:</u>
17	(A) a video that states:
18	(i) the names of the institution's Title IX
19	coordinators and deputy coordinators;
20	(ii) the location and contact information
21	of the institution's Title IX office; and
22	(iii) the services provided by the
23	institution's Title IX office; and
24	(B) the statements described by Subsection

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- 1 (a)(1)(E).
- 2 SECTION 2. Section 51.282(c), Education Code, as amended by
- 3 this Act, applies beginning with the 2025-2026 academic year.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
