## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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3	Relating to a public institution of higher education's orientation
4	on the institution's sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating
5	violence, and stalking policy.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Section 51.282(c), Education Code, is amended to
8	read as follows:
9	(c) Each postsecondary educational institution shall
10	require each entering freshman or undergraduate transfer student to
11	attend an orientation on the institution's sexual harassment,
12	sexual assault, dating violence, and stalking policy before or
13	during the first semester or term in which the student is enrolled
14	at the institution. The institution shall establish the format and
15	content of the orientation. The orientation:
16	(1) may be provided online; and
17	(2) must include:
18	(A) a video that states:
19	(i) the names of the institution's Title IX
20	coordinators and deputy coordinators;
21	(ii) the location and contact information
22	of the institution's Title IX office; and
23	(iii) the services provided by the
24	institution's Title IX office; and

- 2 (a)(1)(E).
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 51.282(c), Education Code, as amended by
- 4 this Act, applies beginning with the 2025-2026 academic year.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
