## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to enrolling a public school student in a virtual
- 3 education program as an alternative to expulsion.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 37, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 37.0071 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 37.0071. VIRTUAL EDUCATION AS ALTERNATIVE TO
- 8 EXPULSION. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), before a
- 9 school district or open-enrollment charter school may expel a
- 10 student, the district or school shall consider as an alternative to
- 11 expulsion the appropriateness and feasibility of enrolling the
- 12 student in a full-time virtual education program through the state
- 13 <u>virtual school network under Chapter 30A or another virtual</u>
- 14 education program authorized by this code.
- (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a student expelled
- 16 under Section 37.007(a), (d), or (e) or 37.0081.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 18 school year.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
