- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 22, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 22.905 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 22.905. PROTECTION FOR USE OF TERMS CONSISTENT WITH
- 8 BIOLOGICAL SEX. A school district or open-enrollment charter
- 9 school may not discipline, retaliate against, or otherwise
- 10 discriminate against a district or school employee who addresses a
- 11 student or another district or school employee in terms consistent
- 12 with the biological sex of the student or employee.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
