## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to required labeling of meat, poultry, shrimp, and certain
- 3 related food products.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 433, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 433.046 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 433.046. LABELING OF MEAT, POULTRY, AND CERTAIN
- 8 RELATED FOOD PRODUCTS. In this state, a person may not sell meat, a
- 9 meat food product, poultry, or a poultry product unless the food's
- 10 label includes a clear and conspicuous notice stating whether the
- 11 food originated in this state.
- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 436, Health and Safety
- 13 Code, is amended by adding Section 436.083 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 436.083. LABELING OF SHRIMP. A person may not sell
- 15 shrimp in this state unless the shrimp's label includes a clear and
- 16 conspicuous notice stating whether the shrimp originated in this
- 17 <u>state.</u>
- SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 19 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 20 Services Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement
- 21 Sections 433.046 and 436.083, Health and Safety Code, as added by
- 22 this Act.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
