## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the operation of a motor vehicle in a school crossing
- 3 zone while intoxicated; increasing a criminal penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 49.04, Penal Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) Except as provided by Subsections (c), [and] (d), and
- 9 (e) and Section 49.09, an offense under this section is a Class B
- 10 misdemeanor, with a minimum term of confinement of 72 hours.
- 11 <u>(e) If it is shown on the trial of an offense under this</u>
- 12 <u>section that at the time of the offense the person was operating the</u>
- 13 motor vehicle in a school crossing zone during the time the reduced
- 14 speed limit applies to the zone, the offense is a state jail felony.
- 15 In this subsection, "school crossing zone" has the meaning assigned
- 16 by Section 541.302, Transportation Code.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 19 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 20 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 21 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 22 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 23 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 24 before that date.
