In this subsection, "school crossing zone" has the meaning assigned 15 by Section 541.302, Transportation Code. 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 17 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 18 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 19 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 20 21 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 22 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 23
