- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 13.001(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) To be eligible to apply for registration, a person must,
- 8 on the date the registration application is submitted to the
- 9 registrar, be at least 17 years [and 10 months] of age and satisfy
- 10 the requirements of Subsection (a) except for age.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 13.046, Election Code, is amended by
- 12 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (d-1) to read as
- 13 follows:
- 14 (d) At least twice each school year, a high school deputy
- 15 registrar shall distribute an officially prescribed registration
- 16 application form to each student who is or will be 18 years of age or
- 17 older during that year, subject to rules prescribed by the
- 18 secretary of state. A high school deputy registrar shall annually
- 19 submit the number of registration application forms distributed
- 20 under this section and the number of students whose year of birth
- 21 was at least 18 years ago to the secretary of state.
- 22 (d-1) The secretary of state shall publish and maintain on
- 23 the agency's Internet website a list of high schools to which
- 24 Subsection (d) applies and indicate whether the school is in

- 1 compliance with that subsection.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
