5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Title 6, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
7	amended by adding Chapter 129C to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 129C. AGREEMENTS PROHIBITING DISCLOSURES REGARDING CHILD
9	SEXUAL ABUSE
10	Sec. 129C.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "act of sexual
11	abuse" means conduct described by:
12	(1) Section 261.001(1)(E), (F), (G), (H), (K), or (L),
13	Family Code; or
14	(2) one or more of the following penal laws:
15	(A) indecency with a child under Section 21.11,
16	Penal Code;
17	(B) sexual assault under Section 22.011, Penal
18	Code;
19	(C) aggravated sexual assault under Section
20	22.021, Penal Code;
21	(D) sexual performance by a child under Section
22	43.25, Penal Code;
23	(E) trafficking of persons under Section
24	20A.02(a)(3), (4), (7), or (8), Penal Code; and

- 1 (F) compelling prostitution under Section 43.05,
- 2 Penal Code.
- 3 Sec. 129C.002. CERTAIN PROVISIONS UNENFORCEABLE. Any
- 4 provision of a nondisclosure or confidentiality agreement, or
- 5 nondisclosure or confidentiality provision of an employment
- 6 agreement, settlement agreement, or any other agreement is void and
- 7 unenforceable as against the public policy of this state to the
- 8 extent the provision:
- 9 (1) prohibits a party from notifying, or limits the
- 10 party's ability to notify, a local or state law enforcement agency
- or any state or federal regulatory agency of any act of sexual abuse
- 12 committed against a child; or
- 13 (2) prohibits a party from disclosing to any person,
- 14 including during any related investigation, prosecution, legal
- 15 proceeding, or dispute resolution, facts surrounding any act of
- 16 sexual abuse committed against a child, including the identity of
- 17 the alleged offender.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
- 19 agreement entered into before, on, or after the effective date of
- 20 this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
