15	(b) Notwithstanding Sections 382.202(g), 382.209, and										
16	382.220, not later than January 1, 2026, the commission shall										
17	distribute to the counties described by Subsection (a) all										
18	available money collected before September 1, 2025, under Section										
19	382.202(e) or 382.302 that was designated for the low-income										
20	vehicle repair assistance, retrofit, and accelerated vehicle										
21	retirement program and is appropriated by the legislature for the										
22	purposes described by this subsection.										
23	(c) The commission shall distribute the money in reasonable
