S.B. No. 865

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the
- 3 use of automated external defibrillators and to a cardiac emergency
- 4 response plan for certain school employees and volunteers.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Sections 22.902(c) and (e), Education Code, are
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (c) Each school nurse, assistant school nurse, athletic
- 9 coach or sponsor, physical education instructor, marching band
- 10 director, cheerleading coach, and any other school employee
- 11 specified by the commissioner and each student who serves as an
- 12 athletic trainer must participate in the instruction in
- 13 $\underline{\text{cardiopulmonary resuscitation and}}$ [$\underline{\text{in}}$] the use of an automated
- 14 external defibrillator. A person described by this subsection must
- 15 receive and maintain certification in cardiopulmonary
- 16 resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator
- 17 from the American Heart Association, the American Red Cross, or a
- 18 similar nationally recognized association.
- (e) \underline{A} [This subsection applies only to a] private school
- 20 that receives an automated external defibrillator from the agency
- 21 or receives funding from the agency to purchase or lease an
- 22 automated external defibrillator or an open-enrollment charter
- 23 school[. A private school] shall adopt a policy under which the
- 24 school makes available to school employees and volunteer nurses

- 1 [volunteers] instruction in the principles and techniques of
- 2 cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external
- 3 defibrillator. The policy must comply with the requirements
- 4 prescribed by this section and commissioner rules adopted under
- 5 this section, including the requirements prescribed by Subsection
- 6 (c).
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 38.018, Education Code, is amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 38.018. [PROCEDURES REGARDING RESPONSE TO] CARDIAC
- 10 EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN [ARREST]. (a) Each school district and
- 11 private school shall develop and implement a cardiac emergency
- 12 <u>response plan that establishes</u> safety procedures for a district or
- 13 school employee or other appropriate personnel [student] to follow
- 14 in responding to a medical emergency involving cardiac arrest on
- 15 <u>district or school grounds</u>[, including the appropriate response
- 16 time in administering cardiopulmonary resuscitation, using an
- 17 automated external defibrillator, as defined by Section 779.001,
- 18 Health and Safety Code, or calling a local emergency medical
- 19 services provider].
- 20 (b) In developing the plan, the district or school shall:
- 21 (1) work directly with local emergency services
- 22 providers to integrate the plan with the providers' protocols; and
- 23 (2) incorporate evidence-based practices of a
- 24 nationally recognized, guidelines-based organization focused on
- 25 emergency cardiovascular care.
- 26 (c) The plan must include at a minimum:
- 27 (1) the establishment of a cardiac emergency response

- 1 team;
- 2 (2) procedures for activating the cardiac emergency
- 3 response team in response to a medical emergency involving cardiac
- 4 arrest;
- 5 (3) the dissemination of the plan throughout each
- 6 district or school campus;
- 7 (4) ongoing training in first aid, cardiopulmonary
- 8 resuscitation, and the use of automated external defibrillators, as
- 9 defined by Section 779.001, Health and Safety Code, using
- 10 evidence-based guidelines, for appropriate district or school
- 11 employees, including school coaches, school nurses, and athletic
- 12 trainers;
- 13 (5) annual practice drills in responding to a medical
- 14 emergency involving cardiac arrest; and
- 15 (6) annual review, evaluation, and, if necessary,
- 16 modification of the plan.
- 17 (d) A private school is required to develop a cardiac
- 18 emergency response plan [safety procedures] under this section only
- 19 if the school receives an automated external defibrillator from the
- 20 agency or receives funding from the agency to purchase or lease an
- 21 automated external defibrillator.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 23 school year.
- SECTION 4. Not later than the first instructional day of the
- 25 2027-2028 school year, each public school and private school to
- 26 which Section 38.018, Education Code, as amended by this Act,
- 27 applies shall implement a cardiac emergency response plan as

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- 1 required by that section.
- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
