A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to authorizing certain cities to change the date on which
3	their general election for officers is held.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 41.0052, Election Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
7	(f) The governing body of a city with a population of 9,000
8	or less, located predominantly in a county that has a total area of
9	less than 6,200 square miles, that has adopted a council-manager
10	form of government and that holds its general election for officers
11	on a date other than the November uniform election date may, not
12	later than December 31, 2026, change the date on which it holds its
13	general election for officers to the November uniform election
14	date. Subsections (b), (c), and (d) apply to the change of ar
15	election date under this subsection. This subsection expires
16	January 1, 2027.
17	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
18	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
19	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
20	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
21	Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
