- 8 REQUIREMENTS. (a) The commission by rule may exempt a [A] person

- 11 established under Section 605.252.
- (b) To be eligible for an exemption under Subsection (a),

- 16 (c) The department shall issue a license <u>under Section</u>

- 24 (d) A person holding a license for which an exemption was

- 5 renewal requirements established by the commission, other than the
- 6 [academic, clinical training, and examination] requirements
- 7 <u>exempted under this section</u>, which the commission may not impose as
- 8 a condition of the person's license <u>renewal</u>.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 605.254, Occupations Code, as amended by
- 10 this Act, applies only to a license application submitted on or
- 11 after the effective date of this Act. An application for a license
- 12 submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 13 law in effect on the date the application was submitted, and the
- 14 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
