## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 22, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 22.012 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 22.012. RELIGIOUS SPEECH OR PRAYER. The right of an
8	employee of a school district or open-enrollment charter school to

- 9 engage in religious speech or prayer while on duty may not be
- 10 infringed on by the district or school or another state
- 11 governmental entity, unless the infringement is:
- 12 (1) necessary to further a compelling state interest;
- 13 <u>and</u>
- (2) narrowly tailored using the least restrictive
- 15 means to achieve that compelling state interest.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
