## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to authorizing the sale or lease by the State of Texas of
- 3 certain real property located in Austin, Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective
- 6 date of this Act, the General Land Office shall offer to sell or
- 7 lease the real property described by Section 2 of this Act under the
- 8 terms provided by this section.
- 9 (b) The General Land Office shall negotiate and close a
- 10 transaction under this section under Section 31.158, Natural
- 11 Resources Code. Proceeds from the transaction shall be deposited
- 12 in a new dedicated account in the general revenue fund, to be known
- 13 as the bicentennial Texas State Library and Archives Commission
- 14 fund. Proceeds from the bicentennial Texas State Library and
- 15 Archives Commission fund shall be used:
- 16 (1) for capital improvements to the Sam Houston
- 17 Regional Library and Research Center and the Lorenzo de Zavala
- 18 State Archives and Library Building; and
- 19 (2) to make original source materials more accessible
- 20 to the public.
- 21 (c) The sale or lease of the real property described by
- 22 Section 2 of this Act shall be contingent upon the construction and
- 23 occupation of an alternative state records facility that replaces
- 24 the facility being operated on the real property by the Texas State

- 1 Library and Archives Commission on the effective date of this Act.
- 2 SECTION 2. The real property to which Section 1 of this Act
- 3 applies is situated in Travis County, Texas, and more particularly
- 4 described as follows:
- 5 20.3127 acres, more or less, located at 4400 Shoal Creek
- 6 Boulevard in Austin, Travis County, Texas, and having a legal
- 7 description of ABS 697 SUR 7 SPEAR G W ACR 20.3127.
- 8 SECTION 3. (a) In this section, "commission" means the
- 9 Health and Human Services Commission.
- 10 (b) As soon as practicable after the effective date of this
- 11 Act, the commission may lease the real property described by
- 12 Section 4 of this Act under the terms provided by this section.
- 13 (c) The commission shall negotiate execution of one or more
- 14 leases under Section 533.087, Health and Safety Code. Proceeds from
- 15 a lease authorized by this section shall be deposited in the Texas
- 16 capital trust fund for the benefit of the commission.
- 17 (d) A lease of all or a portion of the real property
- 18 described by Section 4 of this Act must:
- 19 (1) provide for commission approval and restriction of
- 20 the lessee's proposed use of the property; and
- 21 (2) grant the commission easements to commission
- 22 properties adjacent to the leased property.
- SECTION 4. The real property to which Section 3 of this Act
- 24 applies is situated in Travis County, Texas, and more particularly
- 25 described as follows:
- Approximately 7.5 acres adjoining the south right of way line
- 27 of West 45th street and the East right of way line of Lamar Blvd.,

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- 1 located in Austin, Travis County, Texas, and furthermore being
- 2 described as located in LOTS 79, 80 AND 82, DIVISION D OF THE
- 3 GOVERNMENT OUTLOTS on file in the General Land Office.
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
