| 7  | Sec. 545.256. EMERGING FROM OR ENTERING AN ALLEY, DRIVEWAY,       |
| 8  | OR BUILDING. (a) In this section, "sidewalk user" means an        |
| 9  | individual lawfully operating one of the following on a sidewalk: |
| 10 | (1) a bicycle;  |
| 11 | (2) a motor-assisted scooter, as defined by Section               |
| 12 | <u>551.351;</u>   |
| 13 | (3) an electric personal assistive mobility device, as            |
| 14 | defined by Section 551.201;                                       |
| 15 | (4) a skateboard;   |
| 16 | (5) roller skates; or   |
| 17 | (6) a similar device.   |
| 18 | (b) An operator emerging from an alley, driveway, or              |
| 19 | building in a business or residence district shall:               |
| 20 | (1) stop the vehicle before moving on a sidewalk or the           |
| 21 | sidewalk area extending across an alley or driveway;              |
| 22 | (2) yield the right-of-way to a pedestrian or sidewalk            |

| 24 | (3) on entering the roadway, yield the right-of-way to            |

- 2 (c) An operator entering an alley, driveway, or building in
- 3 <u>a business or residence district from a roadway shall yield the</u>
- 4 right-of-way to a pedestrian or sidewalk user who is located on a
- 5 sidewalk or within the area of a sidewalk extending across the alley
- 6 or driveway to avoid collision.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
