5	SECTION 1. Section 25.00212, Government Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
7	follows:
8	(a) At the end of each state fiscal year, the comptroller
9	shall determine:

11	Section 133.151(c)(1), Local Government Code, from [by] statutory
12	probate courts fees remitted under Section 133.151(a)(1), Local

15	Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System for fees paid
16	using the electronic filing system established under Section
17	72.031; or

- 18 (B) to the comptroller in the manner provided by
- 19 Subchapter B, Chapter 133, Local Government Code, for fees paid to
- 20 <u>an officer of a court;</u> and
- 21 (2) the sum of the amount paid under Section
- 22 25.0022(e) and the total amounts paid to the counties under Section
- 23 25.00211.
- 24 <u>(a-1)</u> If the <u>comptroller determines the</u> total amount

- 1 deposited in the judicial fund by statutory probate courts in all
- 2 counties as calculated under Subsection (a)(1) exceeds the sum
- 3 <u>calculated under Subsection (a)(2) [that sum]</u>, the <u>comptroller</u>
- 4 [state] shall remit the excess proportionately to each county that
- 5 contributed [deposited] a greater amount to [in] the judicial fund
- 6 from fees collected by a statutory probate court than the amount the
- 7 county was paid under Section 25.00211, as adjusted in an equitable
- 8 manner to reflect the differences in the total amounts paid to the

- SECTION 2. Section 25.0022(f), Government Code, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 (f) Each county pays annually to the presiding judge, from
- 13 fees allocated to the judicial education and support fund under
- 14 [collected pursuant to] Section 135.102 [118.052(2)(A)(vi)], Local
- 15 Government Code, the amount of the salary apportioned [to it] as
- 16 provided by this section and the other expenses authorized by this
- 17 section. The presiding judge shall place each county's payment of
- 18 salary and other expenses in an administrative fund, from which the
- 19 salary and other expenses are paid. The salary shall be paid in
- 20 equal monthly installments.
- 21 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 22 25.00212, Government Code, apply to amounts deposited in the
- 23 judicial fund under Section 133.151(c)(1), Local Government Code,
- 24 from fees collected by a statutory probate court before, on, or
- 25 after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
