- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 251, Agriculture Code, is amended by 6 adding Section 251.009 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 251.009. RIGHT OF ACTION. (a) If a political
- 8 subdivision enforces a governmental requirement in violation of
- 9 this chapter, a person aggrieved by the violation may bring an
- 10 action against the political subdivision to obtain declaratory or
- 11 <u>injunctive relief to block the enforcement of the governmental</u>
- 12 <u>requirement.</u>

- (b) A person who prevails in an action under this section
- 14 may recover court costs and reasonable attorney's fees.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 251.009, Agriculture Code, as added by
- 16 this Act, applies only to a cause of action that accrues on or after
- 17 the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
