4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 25.087(b), Education Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(b) A school district shall excuse a student from attending
8	school for:
9	(1) the following purposes, including travel for those
10	purposes:
11	(A) observing religious holy days;
12	(B) attending a required court appearance;
13	(C) appearing at a governmental office to
14	complete paperwork required in connection with the student's
15	application for United States citizenship;
16	(D) taking part in a United States naturalization
17	oath ceremony;
18	(E) serving as an election clerk; [or]
19	(F) if the student is in the conservatorship of
20	the Department of Family and Protective Services, participating, as
21	determined and documented by the department, in an activity:
22	(i) ordered by a court under Chapter 262 or
23	263, Family Code, provided that it is not practicable to schedule
24	the participation outside of school hours; or

- 1 (ii) required under a service plan under
- 2 Subchapter B, Chapter 263, Family Code; or
- 3 (G) attending a course under Section 25.0875;
- 4 (2) a temporary absence resulting from an appointment
- 5 with health care professionals for the student or the student's
- 6 child if the student commences classes or returns to school on the
- 7 same day of the appointment; or
- 8 (3) an absence resulting from a serious or
- 9 life-threatening illness or related treatment that makes the
- 10 student's attendance infeasible, if the student or the student's
- 11 parent or guardian provides a certification from a physician
- 12 licensed to practice medicine in this state specifying the
- 13 student's illness and the anticipated period of the student's
- 14 absence relating to the illness or related treatment.
- 15 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 25, Education Code, is
- 16 amended by adding Section 25.0875 to read as follows:
- Sec. 25.0875. EXCUSED ABSENCE TO ATTEND RELEASED TIME
- 18 COURSE. (a) In this section, "released time course" means a course
- 19 in religious instruction offered by a private entity.
- 20 (b) A school district or open-enrollment charter school
- 21 shall, on the request of a parent or legal guardian of a student
- 22 <u>enrolled at the district or school and subject to the policy adopted</u>
- 23 under Subsection (c), excuse the student from attending school to
- 24 attend a released time course for at least one but not more than
- 25 <u>five hours a week.</u>
- 26 (c) Each school district and open-enrollment charter school
- 27 shall adopt a policy for excusing a student enrolled at the district

or school from attending school to attend a released time course. 1 The policy: 2 3 (1) must require: 4 (A) the student's parent or legal guardian to 5 provide written consent for the student to attend the released time 6 course; 7 (B) the private entity offering the released time course to maintain attendance records and make the records 8 available to the district or school at which the student is 9 enrolled; 10 11 (C) the private entity, parent or legal guardian, 12 or student to assume responsibility for transportation, including 13 transportation for a student with a disability, to and from any location at which the released time course is offered; 14 15 (D) the private entity to make provisions for and 16 assume liability for the student enrolled in the released time course while the student is under the private entity's care; and 17 18 (E) the student to assume responsibility for any schoolwork issued during the student's absence; 19 20 (2) must prohibit: (A) the district or school from using district or 21 school funds, excluding de minimis costs, to facilitate the 22 23 provision of a released time course; and 24 (B) the private entity from offering the released 25 time course on district or school property, unless permitted under a neutral policy of equal access that allows community 26 27 organizations to use district or school property; and

- 1 (3) may not interfere with the ability of the student's
- 2 parent or legal guardian to request or access a released time course
- 3 for the student.
- 4 SECTION 3. Not later than January 1, 2026, each school
- 5 district and open-enrollment charter school shall adopt the excused
- 6 absence policy required by Section 25.0875, Education Code, as
- 7 added by this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
