A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to procedural requirements for uranium mining production 2 3 area authorizations. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 27.0513, Water Code, is amended by 5 adding Subsection (c-1) and amending Subsection (d) to read as follows: 7 (c-1) The commission shall prioritize the conservation of 8 regional groundwater water supplies when establishing the methods 9 10 under Subsection (c) for determining the restoration table values for a portion of an aquifer that the United States Environmental 11 Protection Agency prohibits from being used as an underground 12 source of drinking water. 13 (d) Notwithstanding Sections 5.551, 5.556, 27.011, and 14 15 27.018, an application for an authorization or an amendment to an authorization that allows the permit holder to conduct mining and 16 restoration activities in production zones within the boundary 17 established in the permit is an uncontested matter not subject to a 18 contested case hearing or the hearing requirements of Chapter 2001, 19 Government Code, if: 20 21 (1) the authorization is for a production zone located 22 within the boundary of a permit that incorporates, for each

production zone addressed in the application, a range table of

groundwater quality restoration values used to measure groundwater

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- 1 restoration by the commission;
- 2 (2) the application includes, for each production zone
- 3 <u>addressed</u> in the <u>application</u>, groundwater quality restoration
- 4 values falling at or below the upper limit of the range established
- 5 in Subdivision (1); and
- 6 (3) the authorization is for a production zone located
- 7 within the boundary of a permit that incorporates groundwater
- 8 baseline characteristics of the wells for the application required
- 9 by commission rule.
- SECTION 2. Sections 27.0513(f) and (g), Water Code, are
- 11 repealed.
- 12 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 13 to an application for an authorization or an amendment to an
- 14 authorization that is submitted to the Texas Commission on
- 15 Environmental Quality on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 16 An application for an authorization or an amendment to an
- 17 authorization that was submitted to the commission before the
- 18 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the
- 19 time the application or amendment was submitted, and the former law
- 20 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
