1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the requirement for performance and payment bonds from  
1-22 certain contractors of the Parks and Wildlife Department.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 11.0171, Parks and Wildlife Code, is  
1-25 amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

1-26 (a-1) If the value of a contract under Subsection (a)(2) for  
1-27 constructing, altering, or repairing a public building or carrying  
1-28 out or completing any public work exceeds \$150,000, the department,  
1-29 the executive director, or the executive director's designee shall  
1-30 require the contractor to execute a performance bond and a payment  
1-31 bond to the department before beginning work.

1-32 SECTION 2. Section 11.0171(a-1), Parks and Wildlife Code,  
1-33 as added by this Act, applies only to a contract for which the Parks  
1-34 and Wildlife Department first advertises or otherwise requests  
1-35 bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications, or makes a similar  
1-36 solicitation, on or after the effective date of this Act. A  
1-37 contract for which the department first advertises or otherwise  
1-38 requests bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications, or makes a  
1-39 similar solicitation, before the effective date of this Act is  
1-40 governed by the law as it existed immediately before that date, and  
1-41 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
