- 17 <u>(6)</u> any other person the court determines has a 18 reasonable excuse from service.
- 19 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 20 a grand jury proceeding that begins on or after the effective date
- 21 of this Act. A grand jury proceeding that begins before the
- 22 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 23 date the proceeding began, and the former law is continued in effect
- 24 for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

5 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
