- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 29.030 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 29.030. REFERRAL TO LOCAL INTELLECTUAL AND
- 9 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY AUTHORITY. A school district shall refer
- 10 <u>each student who qualifies to receive special education services</u>
- 11 under this subchapter on the basis of a diagnosed or suspected
- 12 intellectual or developmental disability to a local intellectual
- 13 and developmental disability authority for services or public
- 14 benefits, including services under a Medicaid waiver program
- 15 established under Section 1915(c), Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
- 16 Section 1396n(c)).
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 18 school year.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
