A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the use of the Department of Public Safety image verification system for the purpose of verifying an individual's 3 identity; authorizing a fee. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Section 521.059(c), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 (c) The department shall use the image verification system 8 9 established under this section only to the extent allowed by: (1) Section 521.0591 to verify an individual's 10 identity; and 11 12 (2) Chapter 730[, Transportation Code,] to aid other 13 law enforcement agencies in: 14 (A) [(1)] establishing the identity of a victim of a disaster or crime that a local law enforcement agency is unable 15 16 to establish; or (B) [(2)] conducting 17 investigation an of criminal conduct. 18 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 521, Transportation Code, 19 is amended by adding Section 521.0591 to read as follows: 20 21 Sec. 521.0591. USE OF IMAGE VERIFICATION SYSTEM FOR IDENTITY VERIFICATION. (a) The department may, on entering into a 22 23 memorandum of understanding with a person, verify the identity of an individual by comparing a facial image of the individual to 24

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facial images contained in the image verification system 1 established under Section 521.059. The department may comply with 2 3 a request under this section only if the request includes: 4 (1) a facial image of the individual who is the subject 5 of the identity verification request and any other information the department requires to determine the individual's identity; 6 7 (2) the consent of the individual described by 8 Subdivision (1); and 9 (3) the fee described by Subsection (c). The department may refuse to provide an identity 10 (b) verification under this section for any reason. 11 12 (c) The department by rule shall establish a fee for the submission of an identity verification request under this section 13 14 in an amount sufficient to cover the costs of the department's 15 compliance with this section, including the direct and indirect costs associated with the department's use of the 16 image 17 verification system. (d) Information submitted to the department as part of an 18 19 identity verification request under this section, including all images and personal identifying information, is confidential and 20 not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code. 21 (e) The department shall, after conducting an identity 22 verification or refusing to conduct an identity verification under 23 24 this section, destroy all information submitted as part of the 25 identity verification request. The department shall adopt rules to 26 implement this subsection. 27 (f) The department may contract with a private vendor to

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1	allow the vendor access to the image verification system under
2	Section 521.059 for the purpose of processing identity verification
3	requests under this section.
4	SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2025, the Department
5	of Public Safety shall adopt the rules necessary to implement
6	Section 521.0591, Transportation Code, as added by this Act.
7	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
