- 4 SECTION 1. Section 20.01, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 5 Subdivision (9) to read as follows:
- 6 (9) "Cultural resource site or area," "natural area,"
- 7 "open space area," and "park" have the meanings assigned by Section
- 8 24.001, Parks and Wildlife Code.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 20.05(a), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 10 as follows:
- 11 (a) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly:
- 12 (1) uses a motor vehicle, aircraft, watercraft, or
- 13 other means of conveyance to transport an individual with the
- 14 intent to:
- 15 (A) conceal the individual from a peace officer
- 16 or special investigator; or
- 17 (B) flee from a person the actor knows is a peace
- 18 officer or special investigator attempting to lawfully arrest or
- 19 detain the actor;
- 20 (2) encourages or induces a person to enter or remain
- 21 in this country in violation of federal law by concealing,
- 22 harboring, or shielding that person from detection; or
- 23 (3) assists, guides, or directs two or more
- 24 individuals to enter or remain on a cultural resource site or area,

- 1 <u>natural area, open space area, park, or</u> agricultural land without
- 2 the effective consent of the owner.
- 3 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 4 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 5 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 6 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 7 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 8 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 9 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 10 before that date.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
