7	Sec. 443.2055. DISTRIBUTION OR SALE OF CERTAIN FLAVORED
8	CONSUMABLE HEMP PRODUCTS PROHIBITED. (a) A person commits an
9	offense if the person knowingly distributes, sells, or possesses
10	with intent to distribute or sell a consumable hemp product that is:
11	(1) marketed or packaged to appear similar to a candy
12	or beverage product; and
13	(2) modified by flavoring or coloring to appear
14	similar to a candy or beverage product.
15	(b) An offense under this section is a felony of the second
16	degree.
