A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to certain retail sales of motor vehicles, trailers, and semitrailers by a holder of a converter's license.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 2301.476, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Subsections (h-2) and (h-3) to read as follows:

(h-2) Notwithstanding any other law, a person who holds a converter's license and has a physical presence in this state is not required to hold any additional license or general distinguishing number to sell to a retail purchaser:

(1) a new motor vehicle the person converted, if:

(A) the motor vehicle is a motor vehicle described by Section 2301.002(23)(A) or (B); and

(B) the vehicle manufacturer transferred the chassis and the manufacturer's statement of origin to the person; or

(2) a trailer or semitrailer, as those terms are defined by Section 502.001, Transportation Code, that the person manufactured.

(h-3) A person who sells a new motor vehicle or trailer or semitrailer to a retail purchaser as described by Subsection (h-2) shall be considered a dealer with respect to any responsibility or obligation of a dealer of that type of vehicle to the retail purchaser under this chapter or Subtitle A, Title 7, Transportation

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
6 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
