1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to certain retail sales of motor vehicles, trailers, and
1-24 semitrailers by a holder of a converter's license.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 2301.476, Occupations Code, is amended
1-27 by adding Subsections (h-2) and (h-3) to read as follows:

1-28 (h-2) This subsection and Subsection (h-3) apply only in a
1-29 county that has a river as a border with two other states.
1-30 Notwithstanding any other law, a person who holds a converter's
1-31 license and has a physical presence in a county to which this
1-32 subsection applies is not required to hold any additional license
1-33 or general distinguishing number to sell to a retail purchaser:

1-34 (1) a new motor vehicle the person converted, if:

1-35 (A) the motor vehicle is a motor vehicle

1-36 described by Section 2301.002(23)(A) or (B); and

1-37 (B) the vehicle manufacturer transferred the

1-38 chassis and the manufacturer's statement of origin to the person;

1-39 or

1-40 (2) a trailer or semitrailer, as those terms are

1-41 defined by Section 502.001, Transportation Code, that the person

1-42 manufactured.

1-43 (h-3) A person who sells a new motor vehicle or trailer or

1-44 semitrailer to a retail purchaser as described by Subsection (h-2)

1-45 shall be considered a dealer with respect to any responsibility or

1-46 obligation of a dealer of that type of vehicle to the retail

1-47 purchaser under this chapter or Subtitle A, Title 7, Transportation

1-48 Code.

1-49 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

1-50 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

1-51 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

1-52 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

1-53 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
