1-21 relating to the administration of botulinum toxin by dentists.
 1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 258, Occupations Code, is
 1-24 amended by adding Section 258.0531 to read as follows:
 1-25 Sec. 258.0531. USE OF BOTULINUM TOXIN. (a) A dentist may,
 1-26 for aesthetic purposes, administer to a patient's oral and
 1-27 maxillofacial regions a neuromodulator containing botulinum toxin
 1-28 or a biosimilar or bioequivalent neuromodulator only if the dentist
 1-29 has completed a course of training approved by the board on the
 1-30 administration of the neuromodulator.
 1-31 (b) The board shall adopt rules to implement this section.
 1-32 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2025, the State Board
 1-33 of Dental Examiners shall adopt the rules required by Section
 1-34 258.0531, Occupations Code, as added by this Act.
 1-35 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
