S.B. No. 1159

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the prohibited report or disclosure of certain health 3 information by physicians and other health care providers. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subtitle H, Title 2, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Chapter 171A to read as follows: 6 7 CHAPTER 171A. PROHIBITED REPORT OR DISCLOSURE OF CERTAIN HEALTH 8 INFORMATION 9 Sec. 171A.001. PROHIBITED REPORT OR DISCLOSURE ΒY PHYSICIANS AND OTHER HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS. Notwithstanding any 10 other law, a physician or other health care provider who provides 11 health care services to a patient who experienced a miscarriage or 12 obtained an abortion or who the physician or provider suspects may 13 have experienced a miscarriage or obtained an abortion is 14 prohibited from reporting or disclosing that information to a peace 15 16 officer or law enforcement agency. Sec. 171A.002. ENFORCEMENT. A physician's or other health 17 care provider's report or disclosure of information prohibited 18 under Section 171A.001 constitutes a violation of Chapter 181 and 19 the physician or provider is subject to enforcement actions under 20 Subchapter E of that chapter, including disciplinary action by the 21 22 appropriate licensing authority. Sec. 171A.003. RULES. The executive commissioner may adopt 23 24 rules to implement this chapter.

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1 SECTION 2. Chapter 171A, Health and Safety Code, as added by 2 this Act, applies only to the report or disclosure of information 3 described by that chapter that occurs on or after the effective date 4 of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
