- Sec. 234.0025. REGULATION OF JUNKYARDS, AUTOMOTIVE 8
- WRECKING AND SALVAGE YARDS, AND RECYCLING BUSINESSES. (a) This 9
- section applies only to a county: 10
- 11 (1) in which a municipality with a population of
- 12 500,000 or more is located; and
- 13 (2) that is located on an international border.
- 14 (b) The commissioners court of a county by order may
- regulate the operation of a junkyard, automotive wrecking and 15
- 16 salvage yard, or recycling business located in the unincorporated
- area of the county. 17
- (c) A commissioners court may not include in an order 18
- adopted under this section a requirement that conflicts with a 19
- similar requirement prescribed by another law governing a junkyard, 20

- including a requirement prescribed by Chapter 391, 396, or 397, 22

- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
