Section 659.303, Government Code, is amended by 13 amending Subsections (a) and (d) and adding Subsection (a-1) to 14 15 read as follows: The department may include hazardous duty pay in the 16 (a) compensation paid to an individual for services rendered during a 17 month if the individual[+ 18 [(1)] has: 19 (1) [(A)] routine direct contact with youth: 20 21 (A) [(i)] placed in a residential facility of the 22 department; or 23 (B) [(ii)] released under the department's 24 supervision; and

1 (2) [(B)] completed at least 12 months of lifetime 2 service credit not later than the last day of the preceding month. (a-1) The department shall include hazardous duty pay in the 3 compensation paid to an individual for services rendered during a 4 month if the individual[; or 5 [(2)] is an investigator, inspector general, security 6 7 officer, or apprehension specialist employed by the office of [the] inspector general of the department. 8 9 (d) Except for the inclusion of hazardous duty pay in the compensation paid to an individual described by Subsection (a-1) 10 11 $\left[\frac{(a)(2)}{2}\right]$, the department may not pay hazardous duty pay: (1)funds 12 from authorized for payment of an 13 across-the-board employee salary increase; or (2) to an employee who works at the department's 14 15 central office. 16 SECTION 3. Section 661.918(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 17 (a) This section applies to a peace officer under Article 18 2A.001, Code of Criminal Procedure, who is commissioned as a law 19 enforcement officer or agent, including a ranger, by: 20 the Public Safety Commission and the director of 21 (1)the Department of Public Safety; 22 the Parks and Wildlife Commission; 23 (2) 24 (3) the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission; 25 (4) the attorney general; (5) the insurance fraud unit of the Texas Department 26 27 of Insurance; [or]

4	SECTION 4. Section 242.102, Human Resources Code, is
5	amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
6	(j) The department shall ensure that a peace officer
7	commissioned under Subsection (d) is compensated according to
8	Schedule C of the position classification salary schedule
9	prescribed by the General Appropriations Act.
10	SECTION 5. (a) The classification officer in the office of
11	the state auditor shall classify the position of commissioned peace
12	officer employed by the office of inspector general of the Texas
13	Juvenile Justice Department as a Schedule C position under the
14	position classification plan maintained under Chapter 654,
15	Government Code.
16	(b) The change made by the classification officer as
17	required by this section applies beginning with the state fiscal
18	biennium beginning September 1, 2025.
19	(c) This section expires September 1, 2027.
20	SECTION 6. Section 661.918(a), Government Code, as amended
21	by this Act, applies only to an injury that occurs on or after the
22	effective date of this Act.
23	SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
