## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the development of a standard method of computing a student's high school grade point average. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Sections 28.0252(a) and (b), Education Code, are 5 amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) The commissioner <u>shall</u> [may] develop a standard method of computing a student's high school grade point average that 8 9 provides for additional weight to be given to each honors course, advanced placement course, international baccalaureate course, or 10 dual credit course completed by a student. The method must provide 11 for an equal amount of additional weight to be given to an advanced 12 placement course, an international baccalaureate course, and a dual 13 14 credit course. A [If the commissioner develops a standard method under 15 (b) 16 this section, a] school district shall use the standard method

17 <u>developed by the commissioner under Subsection (a)</u> to compute a 18 student's high school grade point average.

19 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date 20 of this Act, the commissioner of education shall develop a standard 21 method of computing a student's high school grade point average as 22 required by Section 28.0252(a), Education Code, as amended by this 23 Act.

24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
